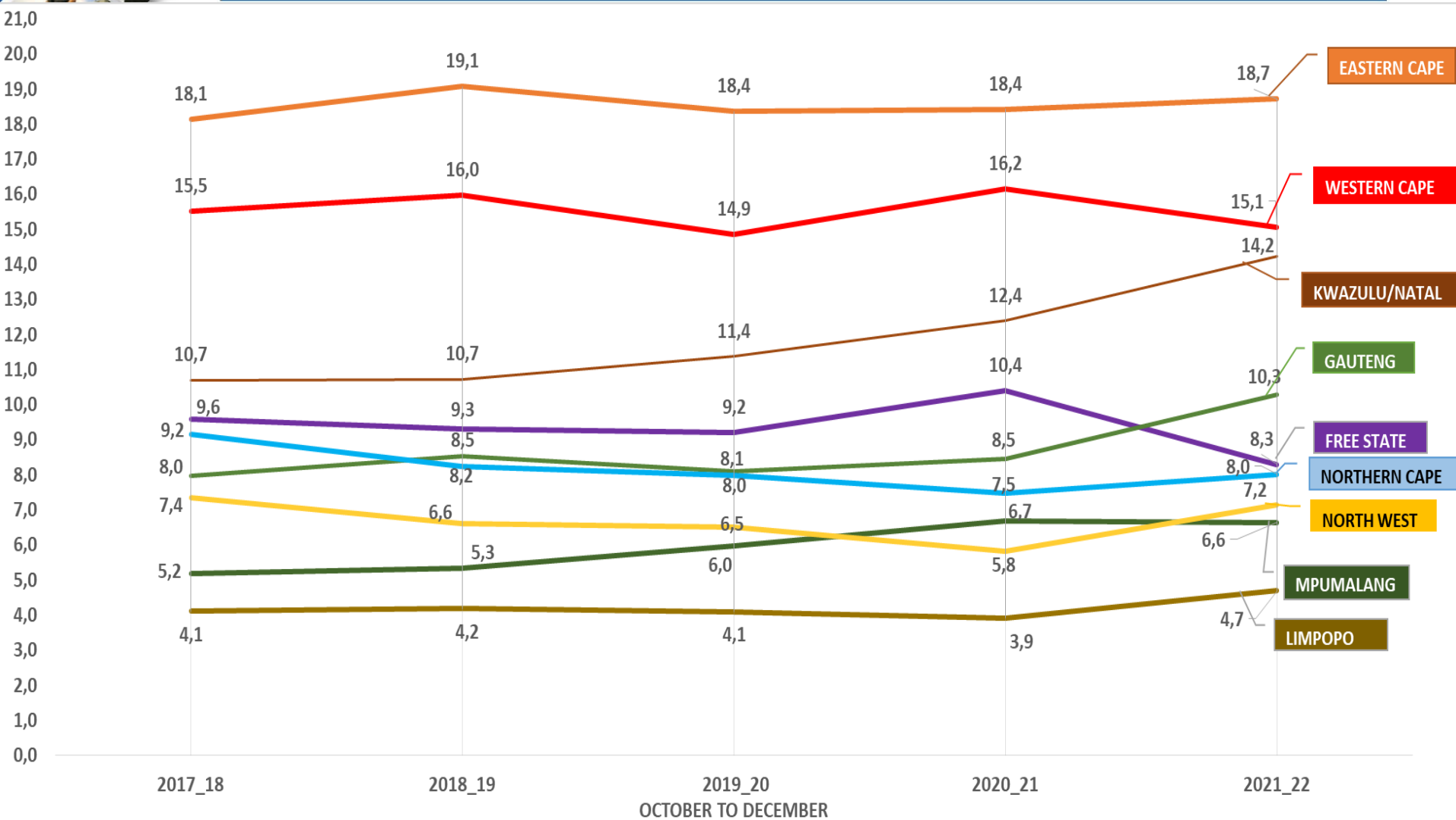

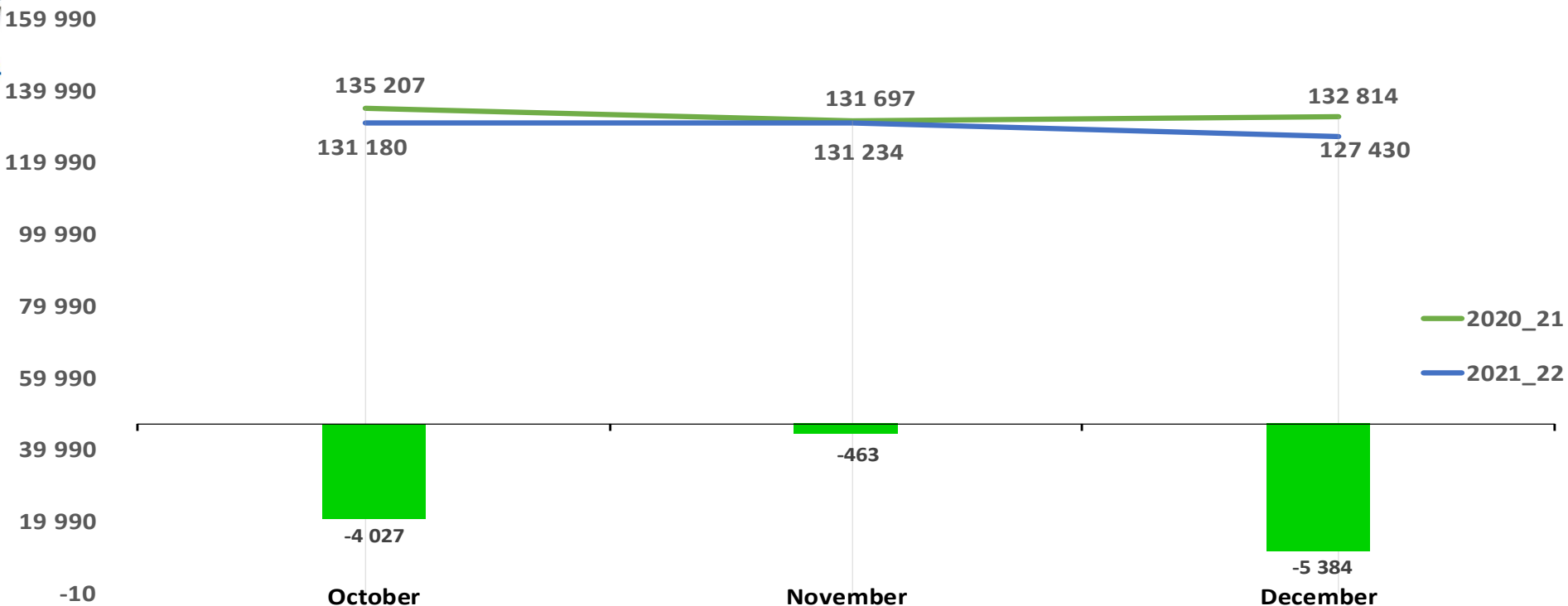

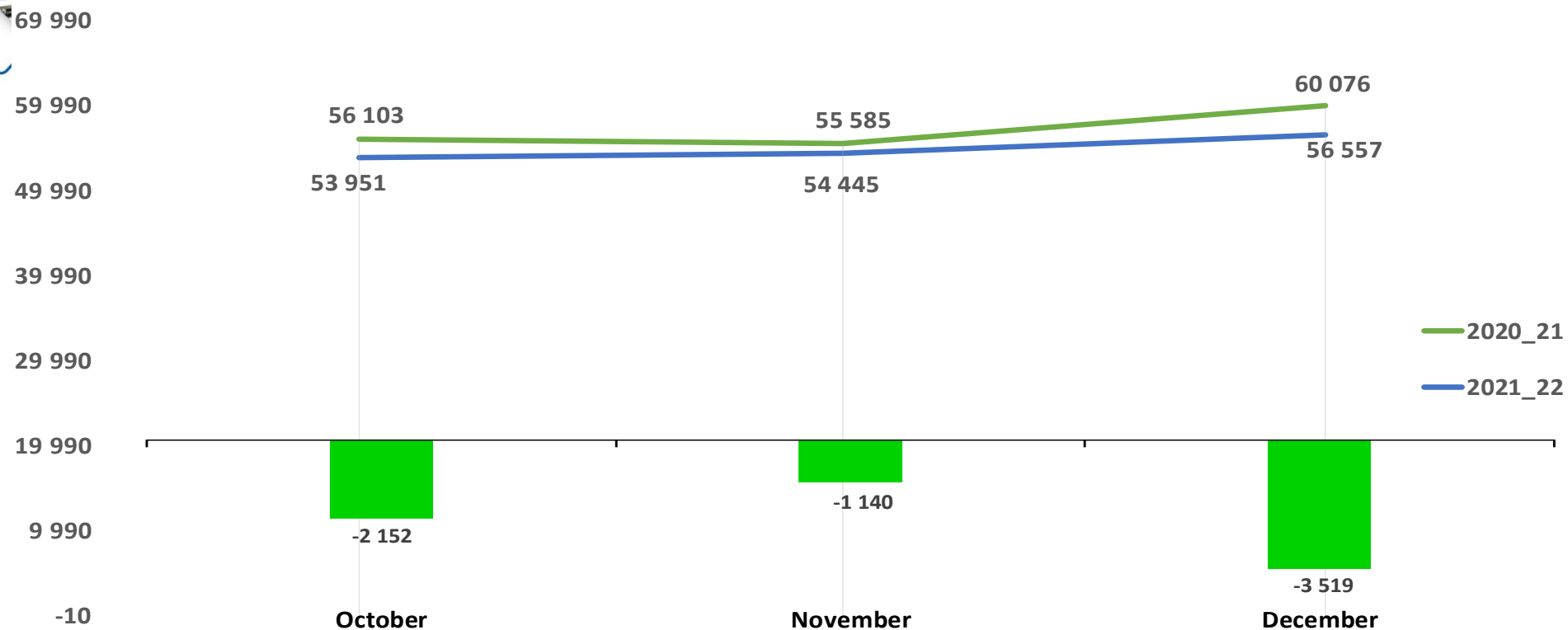

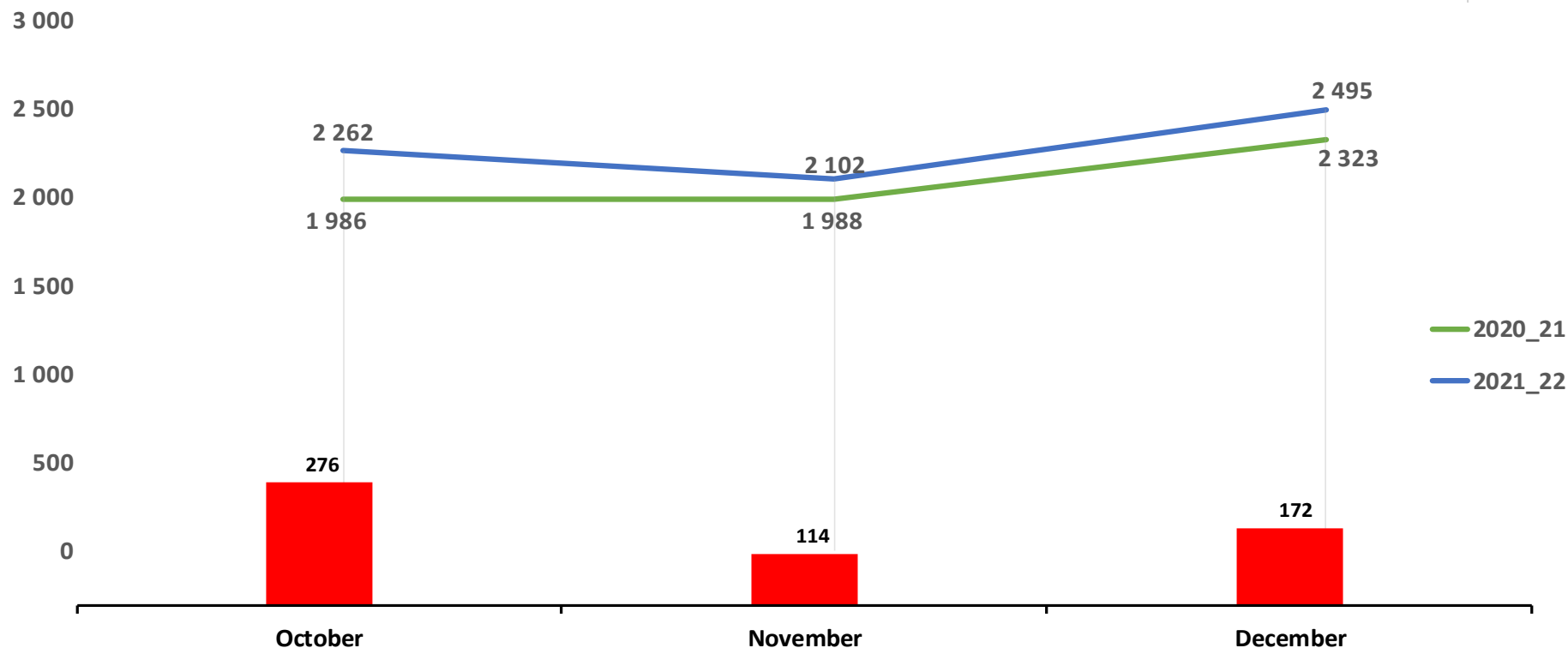

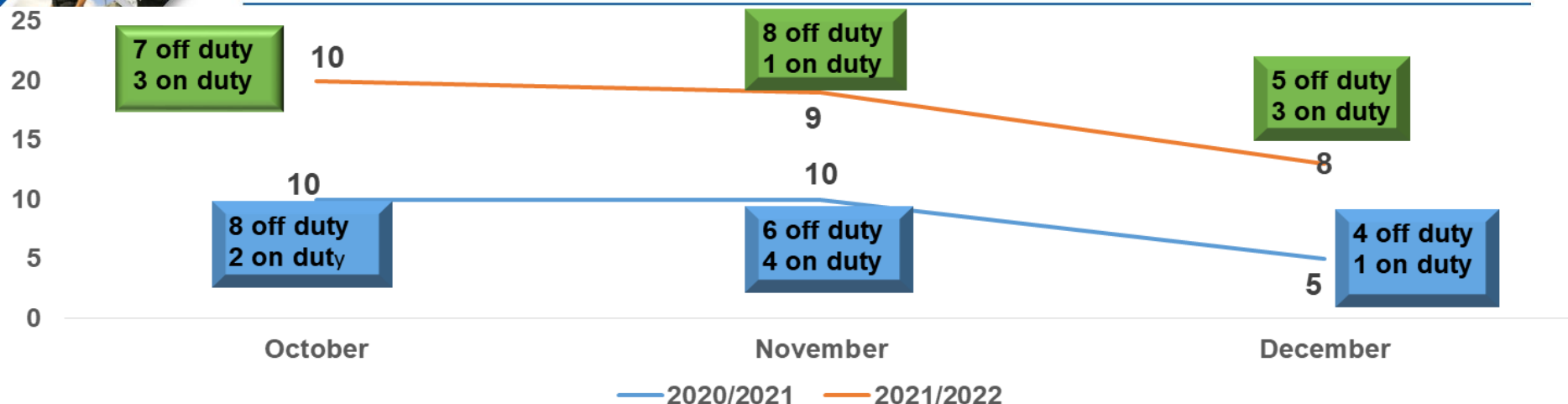

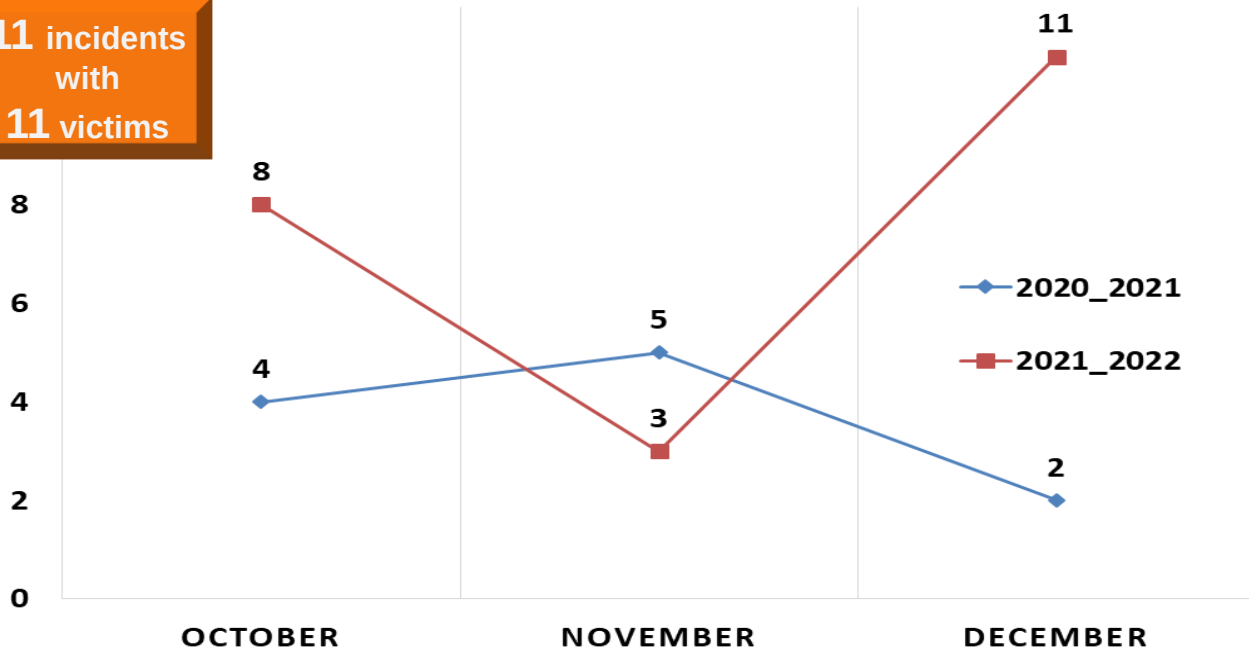

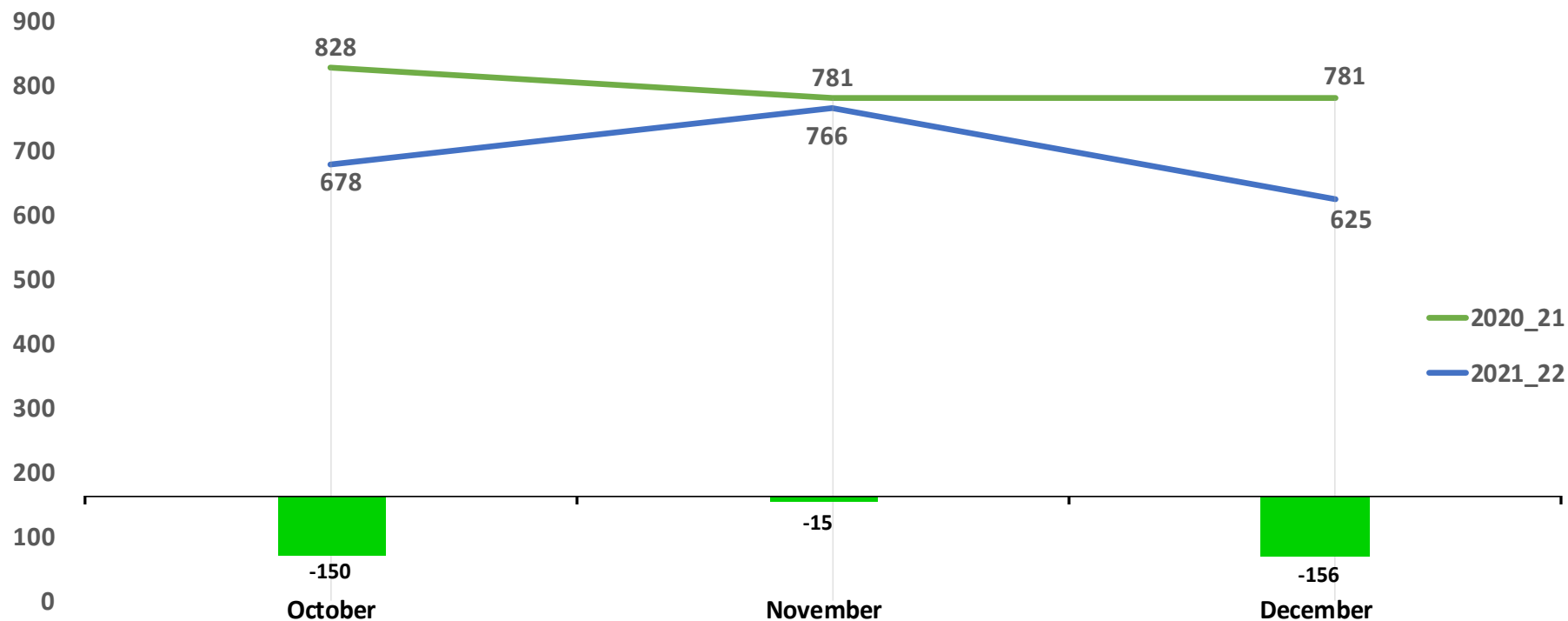

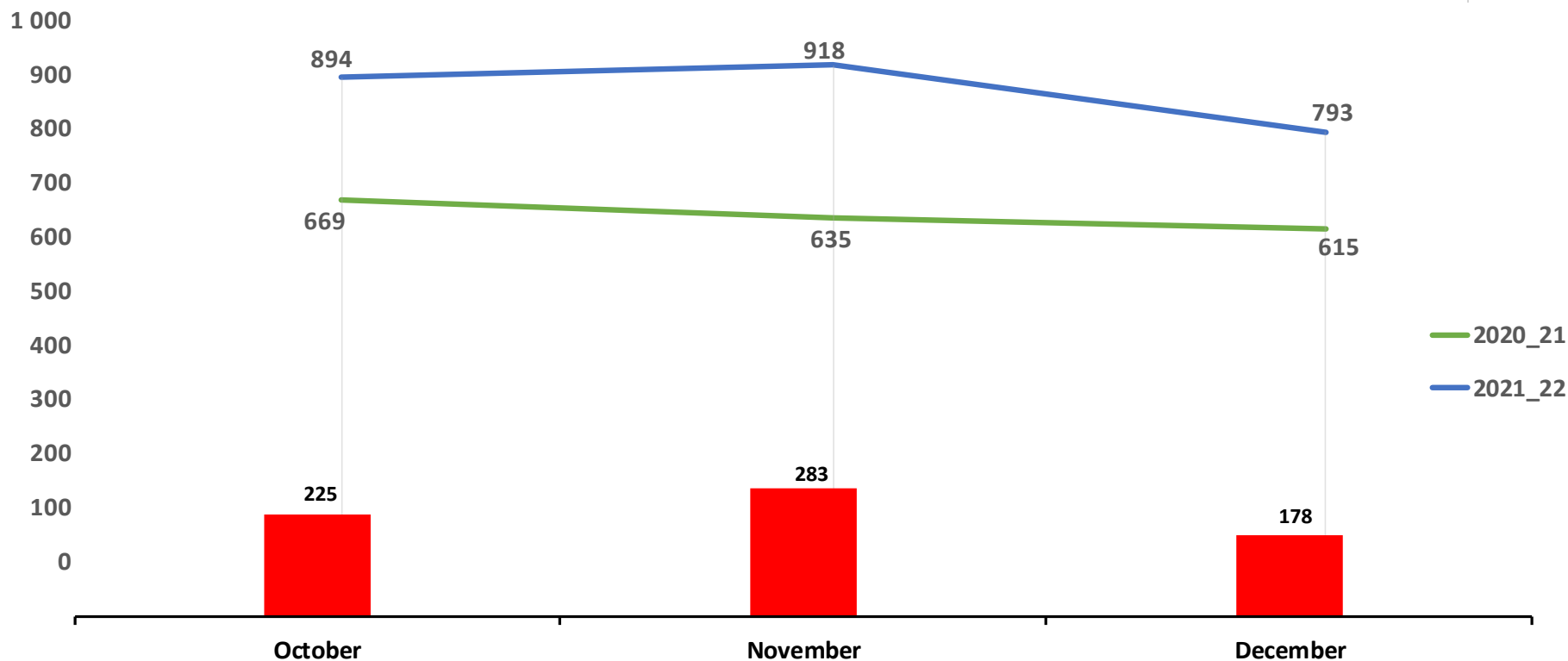

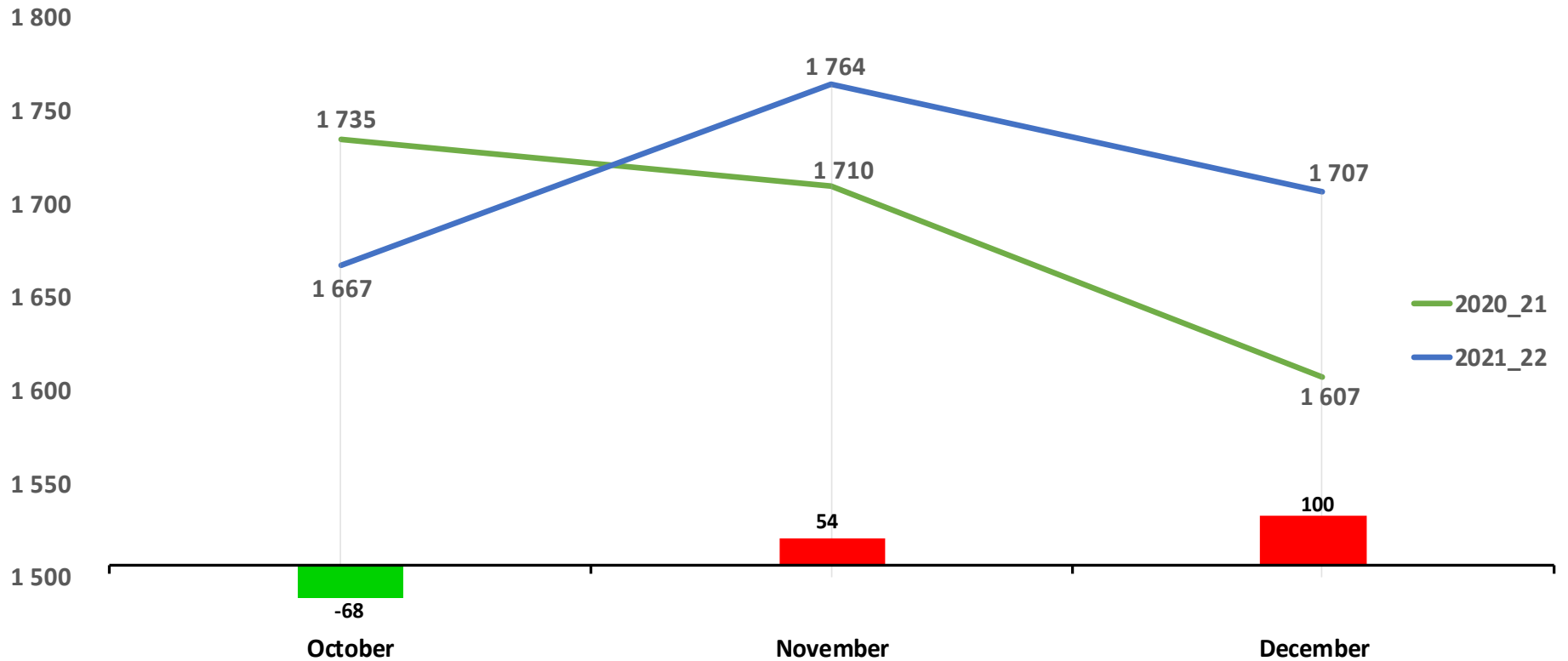

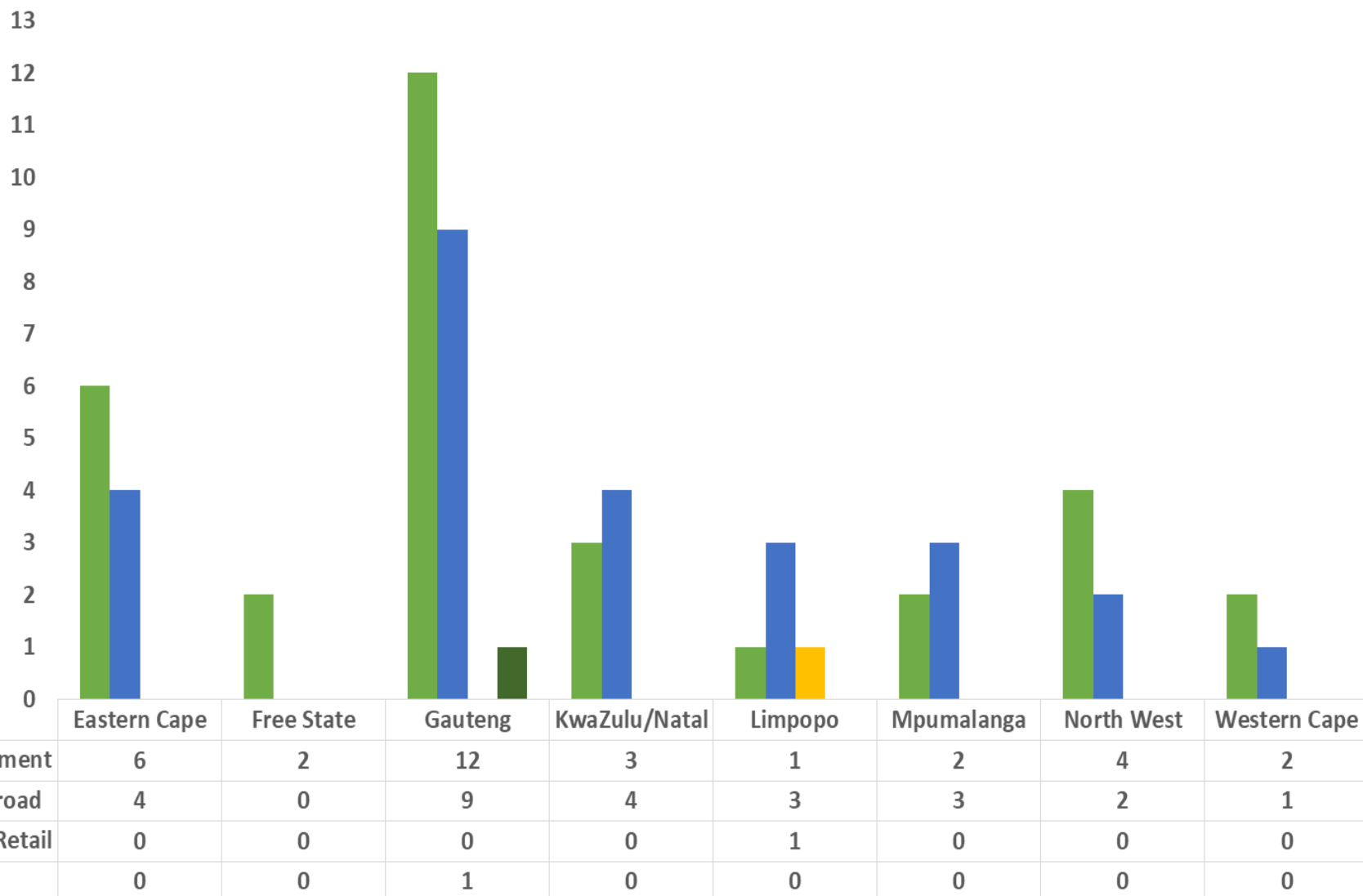

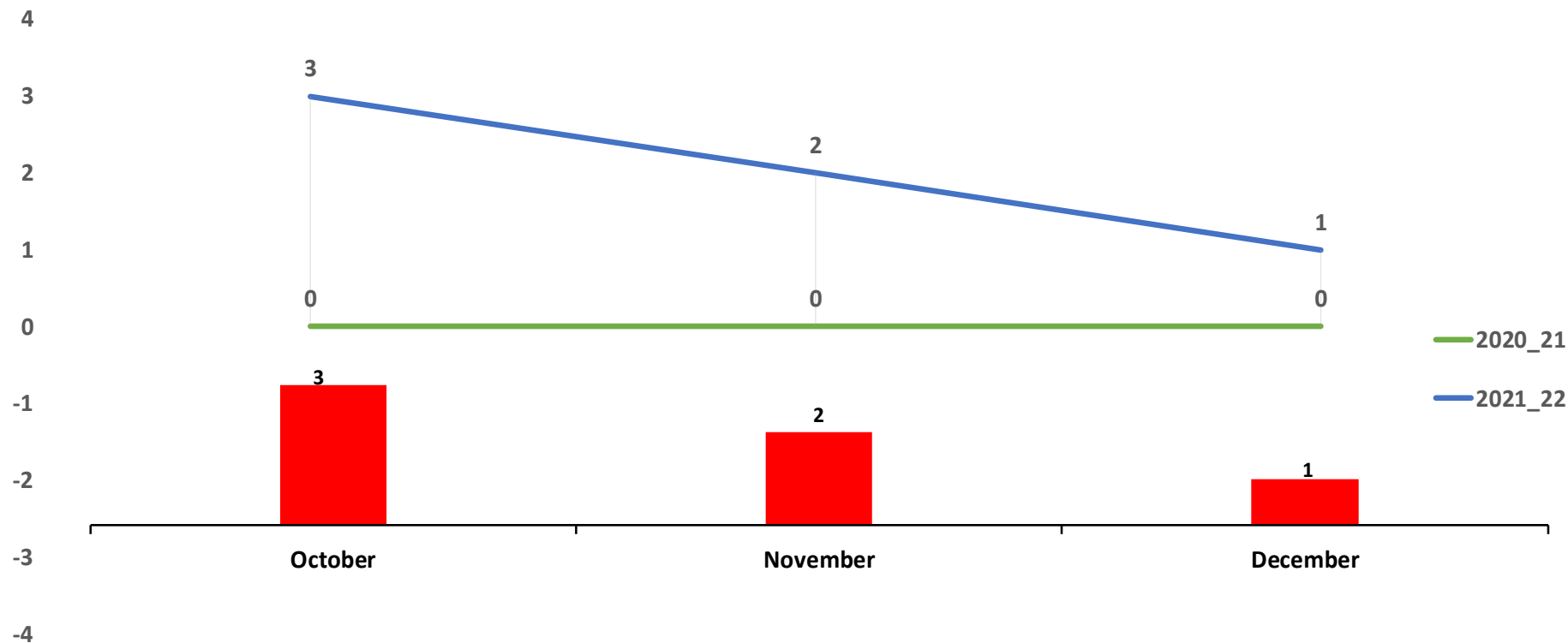


TYPE OF ROBBERY OF CASH IN TRANSIT OCT TO DEC 2021/2022

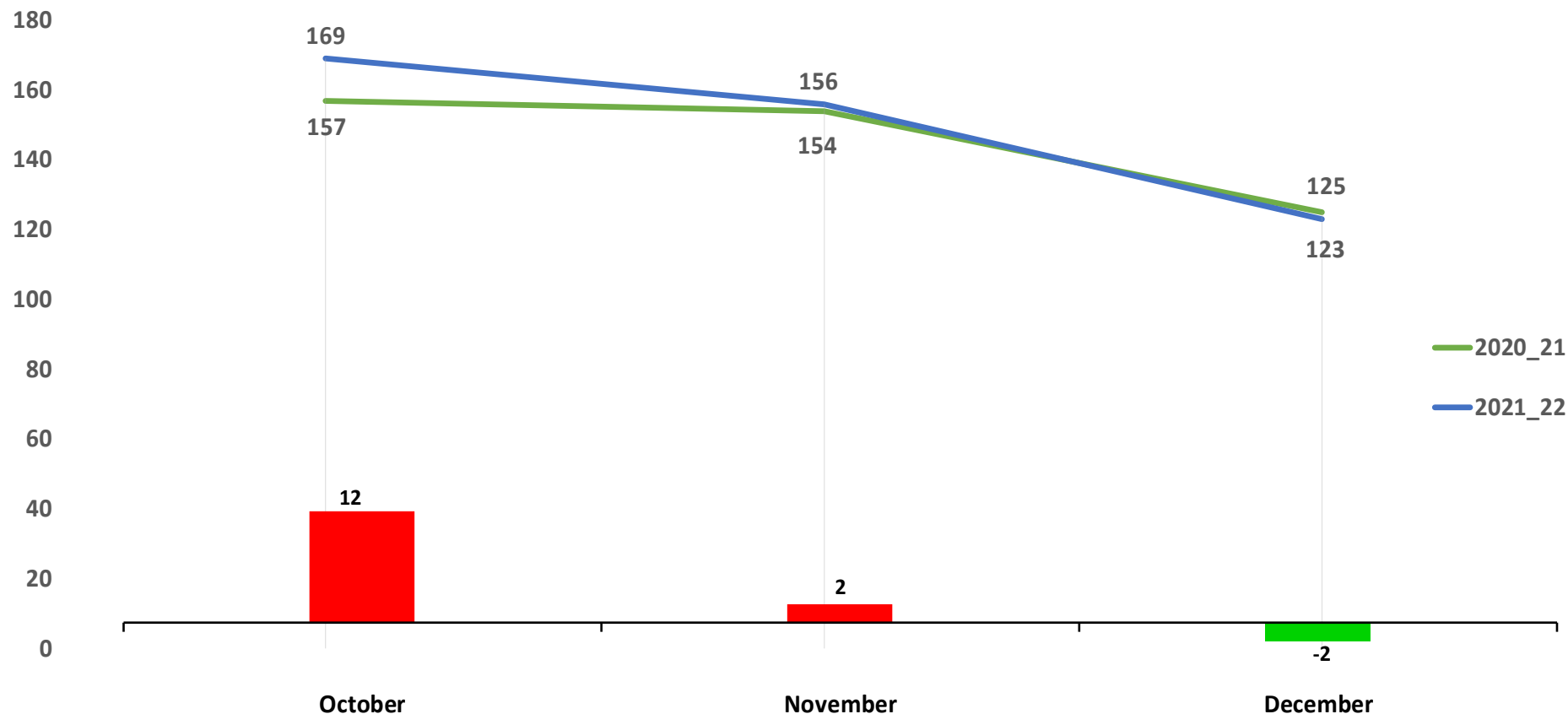

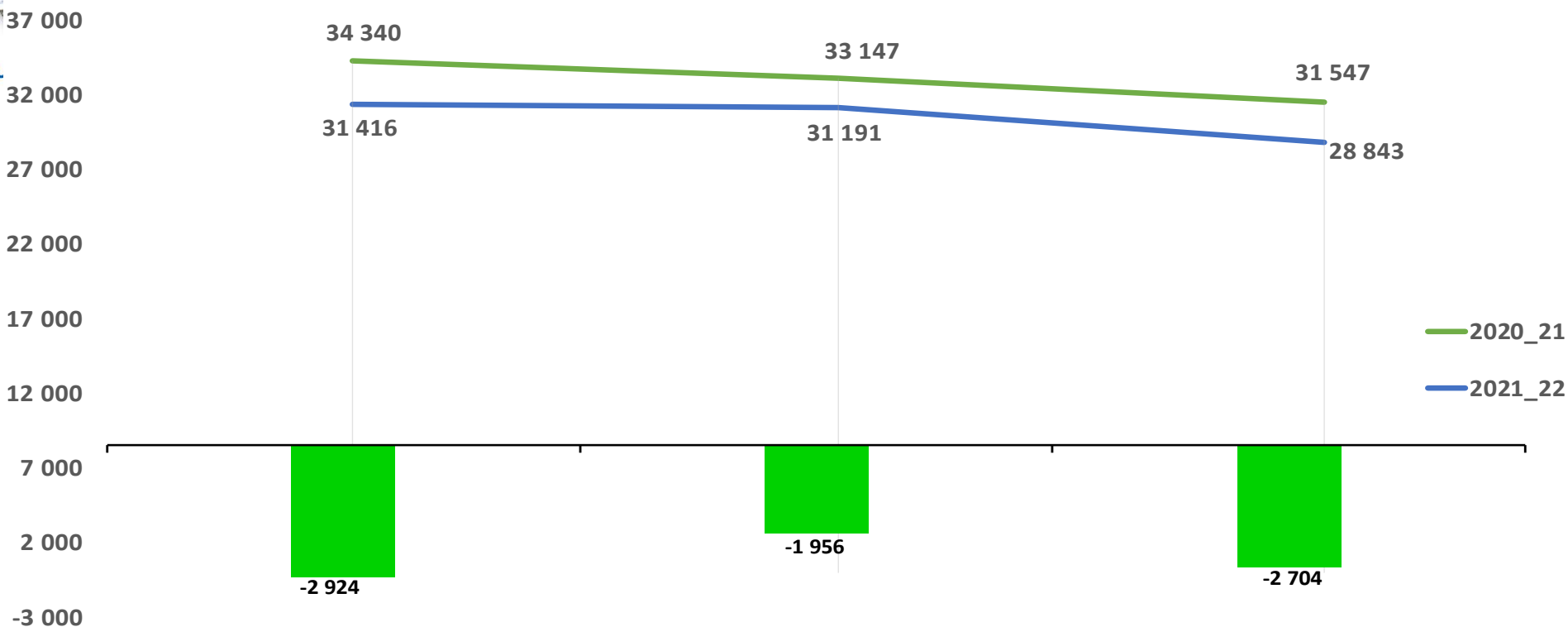

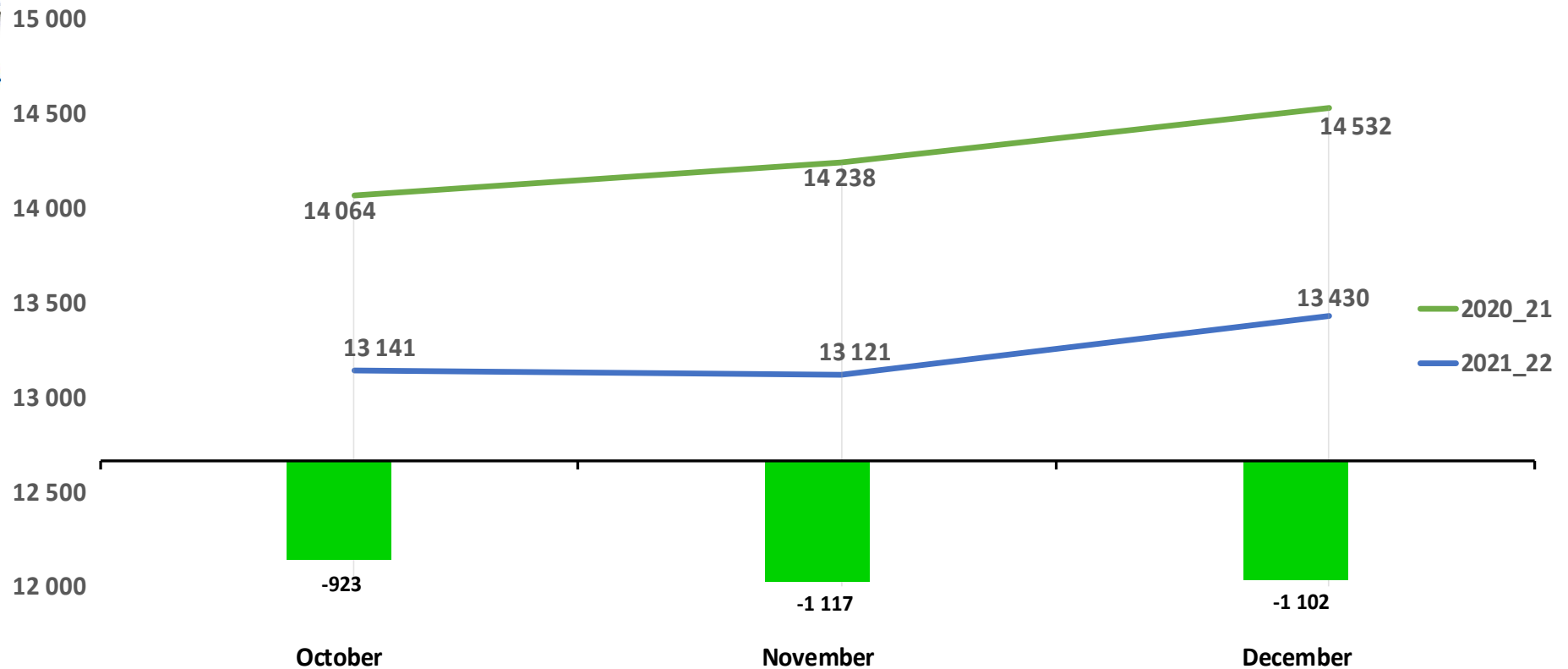

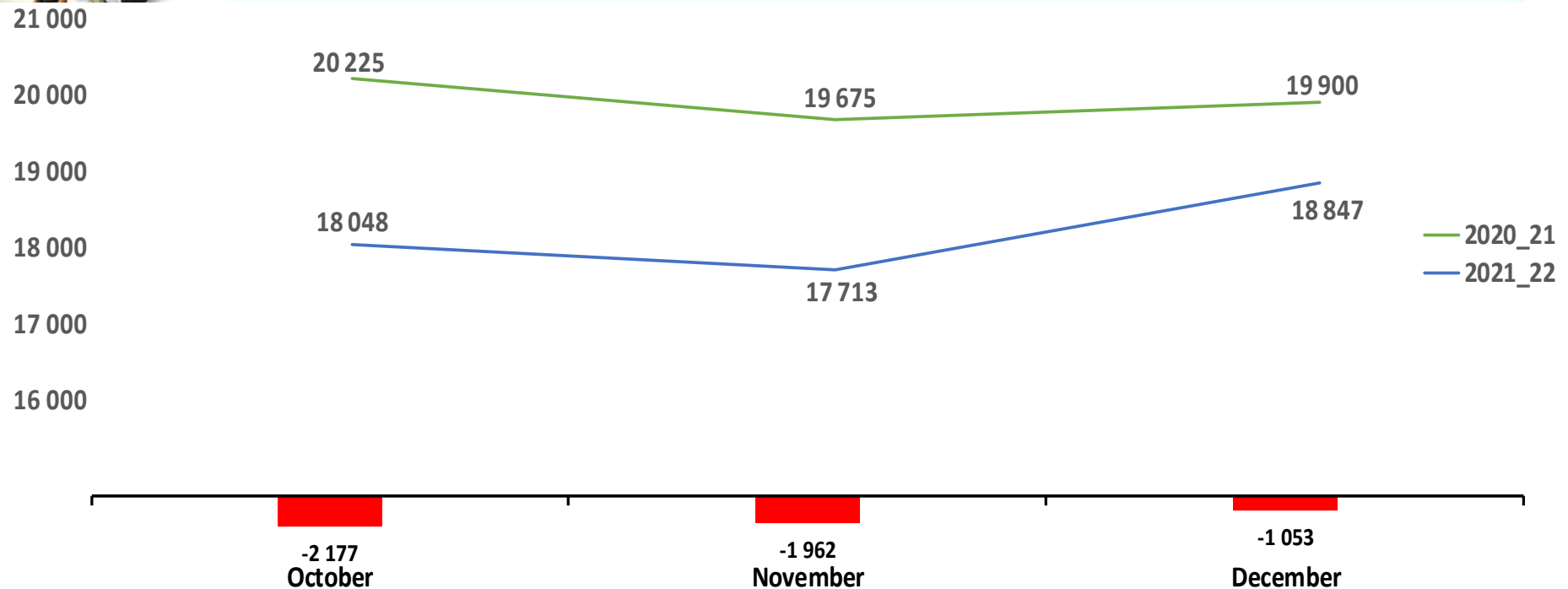
